**For the right candidate, there may be some flexibility regarding schedule to pro-rate the position and compensation to 30 hours per week, if that is their preference.*

Responsibilities will include:

- Cleaning of, but not limited to, Gateway Theatre including main stage, studios, lobbies, office spaces, washrooms, dressing rooms, and common areas.
- Setting up and taking down of event equipment including tables and chairs.
- Liaising with external contractors and/or trades workers including the City of Richmond.
- Maintaining effective oral and written communications.
- Operating and maintaining powered cleaning equipment.
- Completing inventory, ordering and distributing of supplies throughout the facility.
- Identifying maintenance problems and reporting work required.
- Completing minor maintenance (changing light bulbs, unclogging toilets, etc.).
- Opening and closing of facility.
- Other related duties as required.
